## **Instructions for Online Registration for VPN Connection**

- 1. All users are requested to go through the NIC VPN Policy before applying for a VPN connection.
- 2. The link for Online Registration is on <a href="http://10.1.8.15/vpn.html">http://10.1.8.15/vpn.html</a>
- 3. For external users, the NIC coordinator has to guide the user for registration.
- 4. The user who wants to use the digital certificate issued by NICCA, can refer to 'Procedure to Register for a VPN Connection' on the main page.
- 5. Instead of URL/Domain name, the IP address of website, FTP server and database server (which has to be accessed) has to be mentioned.
- 6. Section II of the printed form generated from Online Registration has to be filled and duly stamped by the HOD/website owner of the server/website.
- 7. Section III of the printed form generated from Online Registration has to be filled and duly stamped by the NIC Coordinator.
- 8. The completed form has to be signed, stamped and sent to following address,

- 9. Each user will be provided a VPN account which will be valid for a maximum of 2 years.
- 10. The VPN account details will be communicated through official e-mail.
