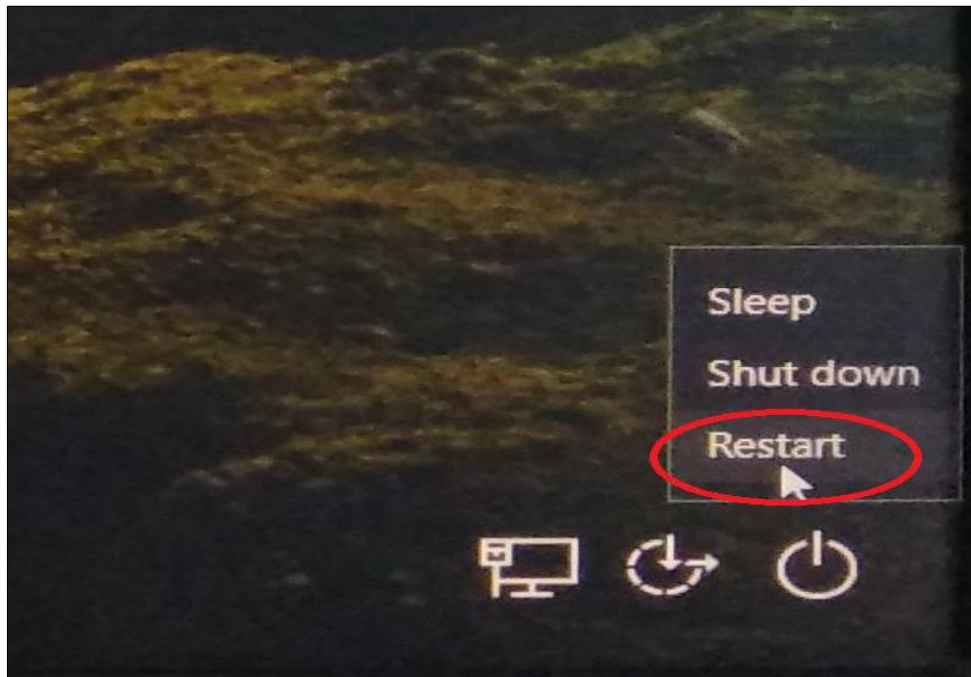

Problem: After updating the Windows 10, there is no login screen

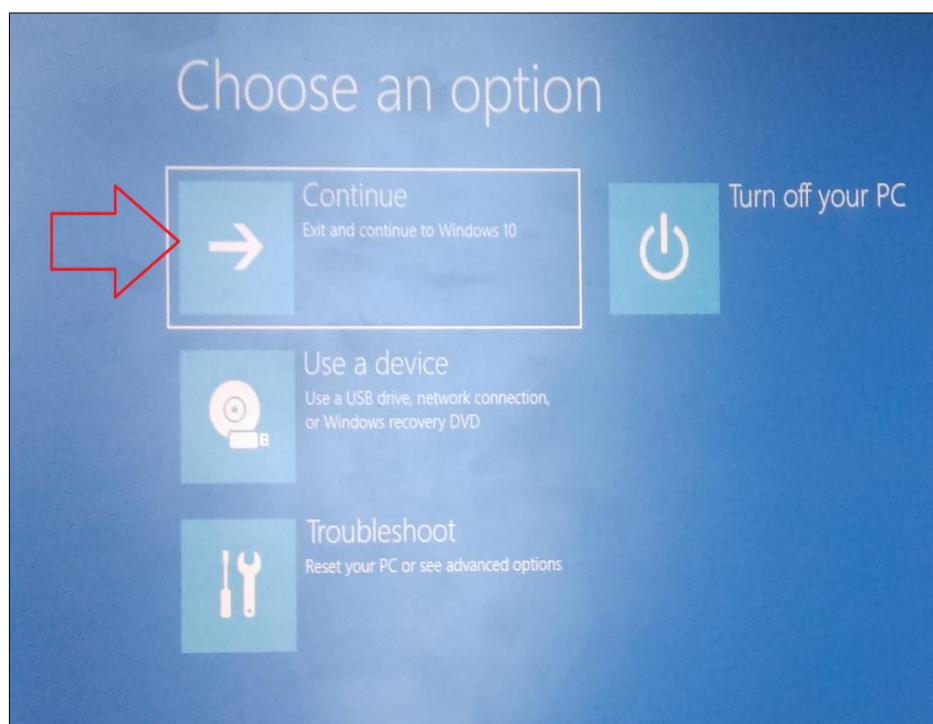
Solution: Follow the below steps to get the login screen

1. Press shift key & restart the system as shown below

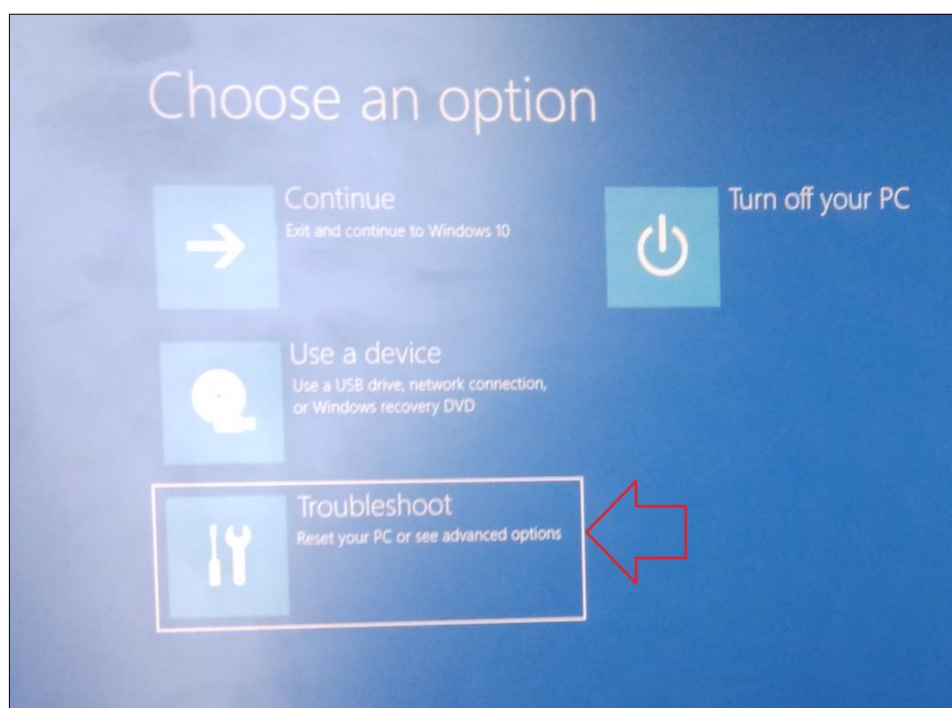


2. Click on continue as shown below

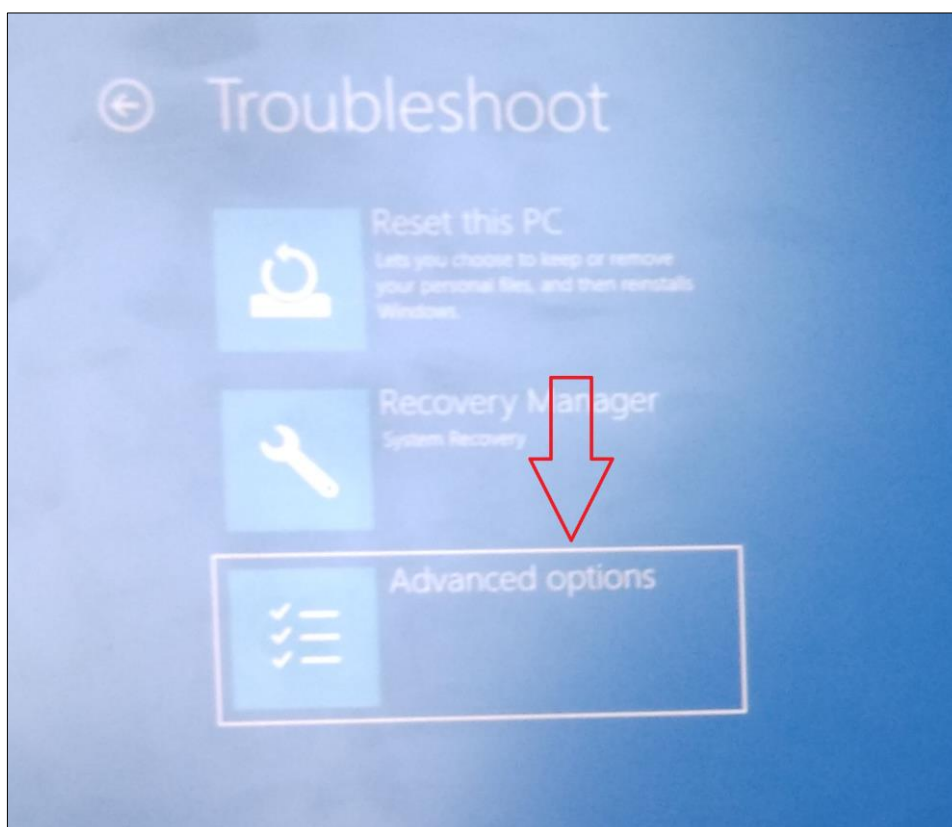


3. Click on troubleshoot option as shown below

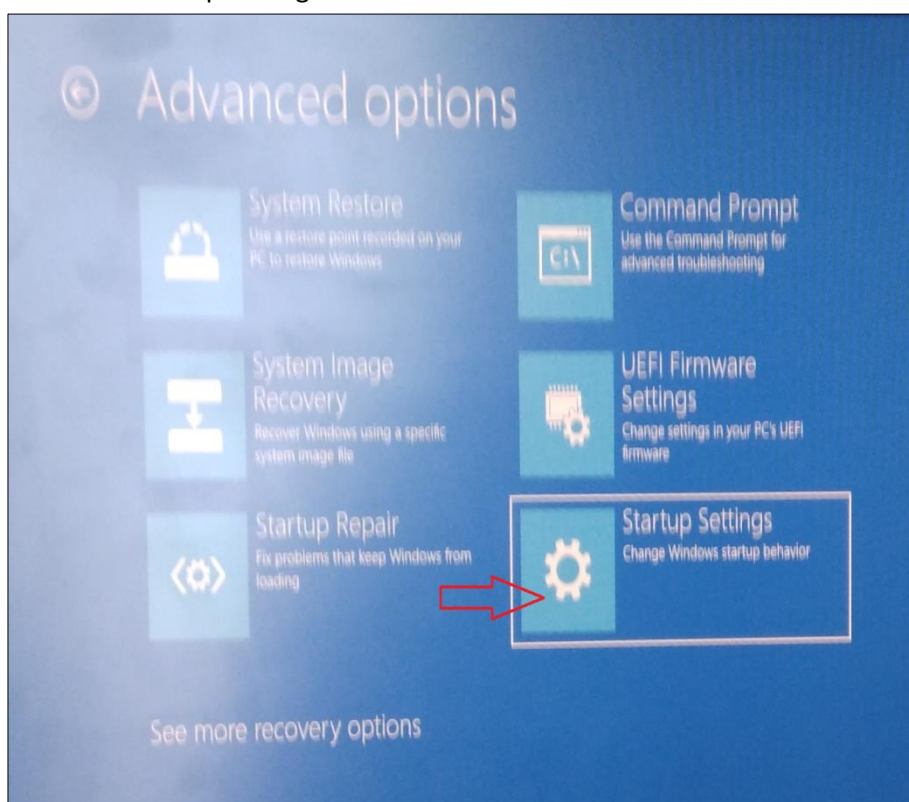


4. Click on Advanced options

5. Click on Start-up setting as shown below

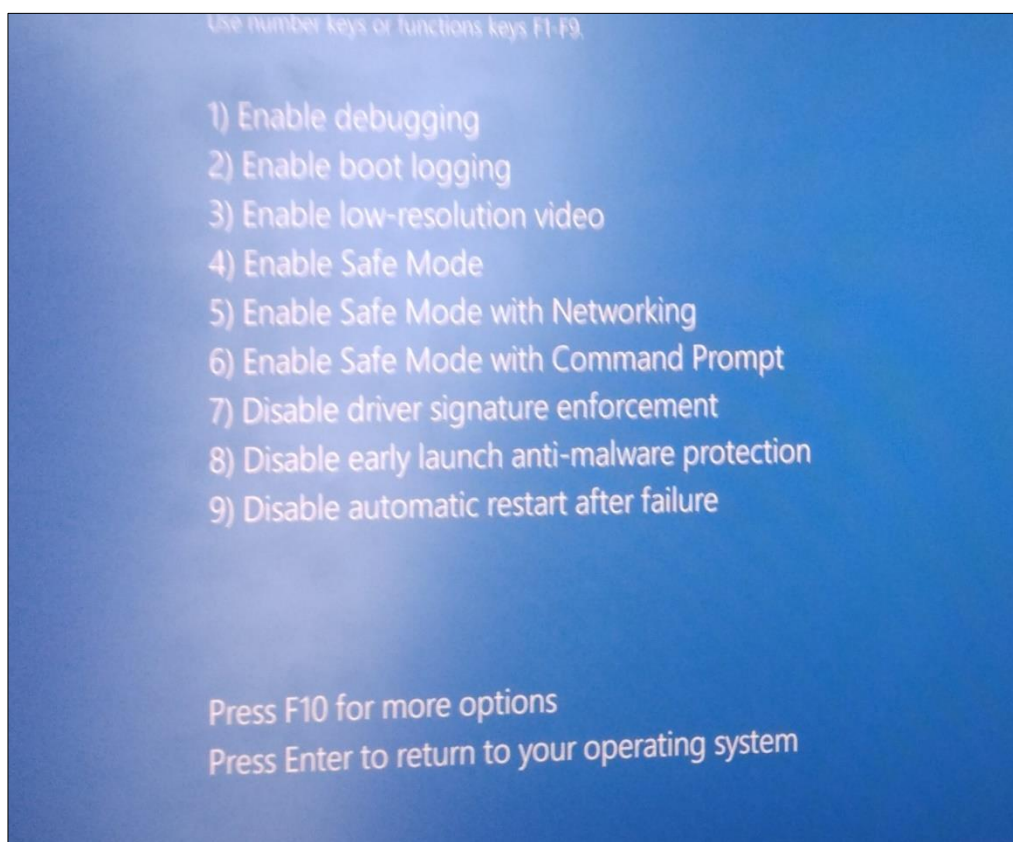

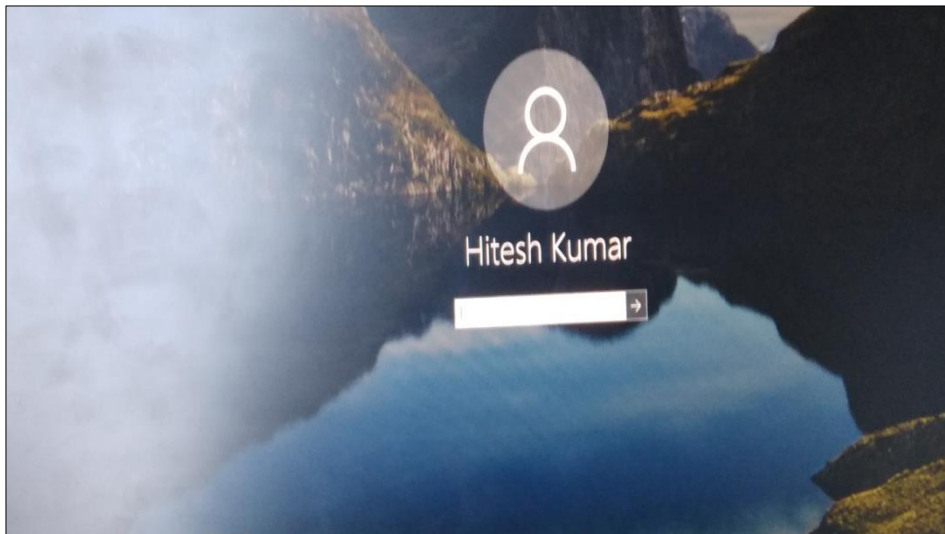

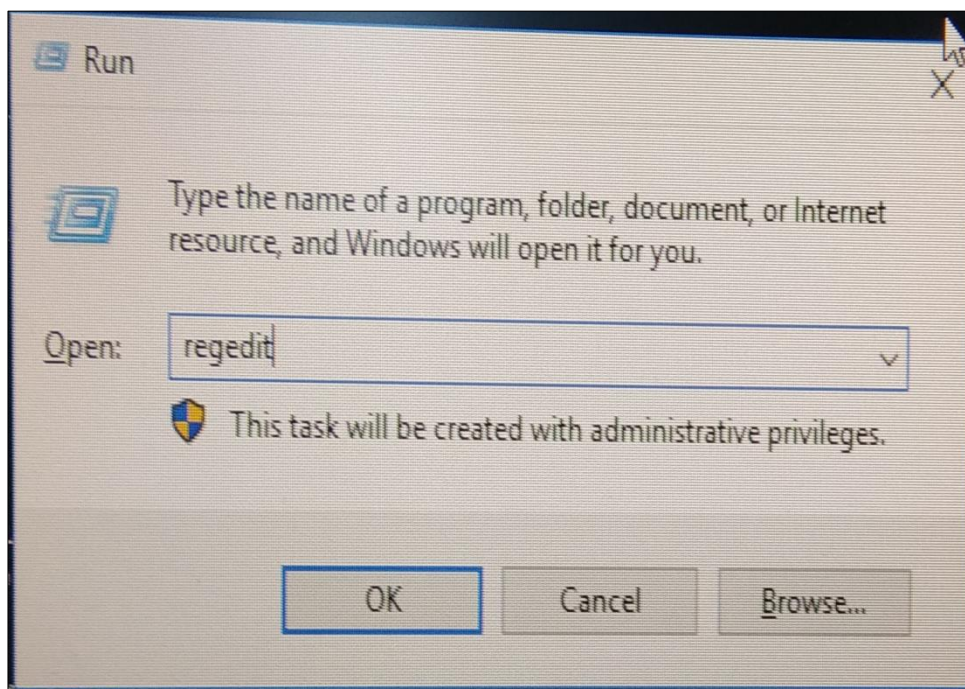


8. Now enter the password

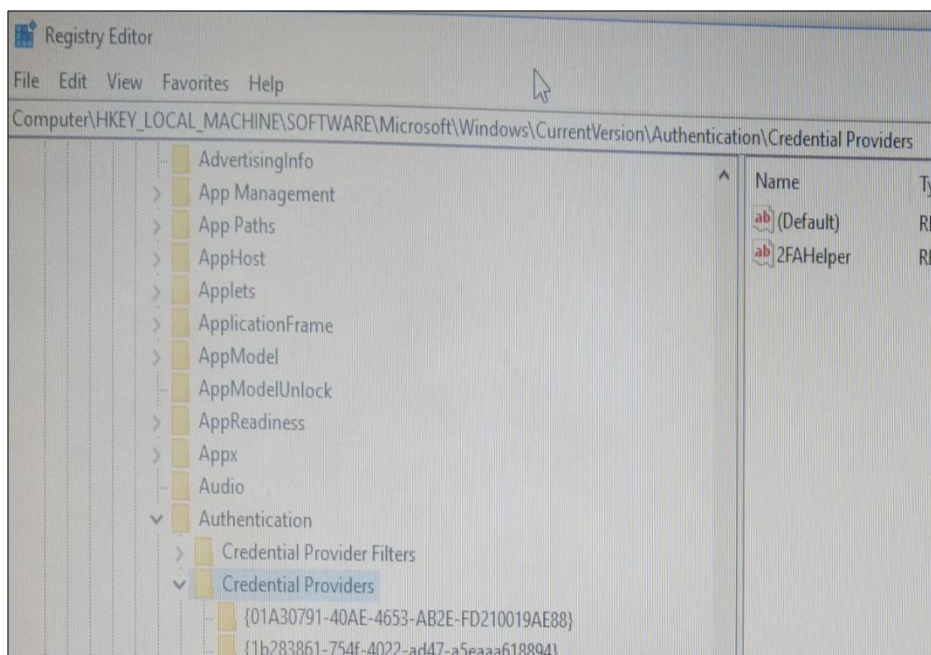
9. Go to run & press windows+r key & write regedit
